A skills test (Part 3) with an AHA Instructor ensures skills proficiency. Upon successful completion of all three parts students receive their healthcare provider course completion card.

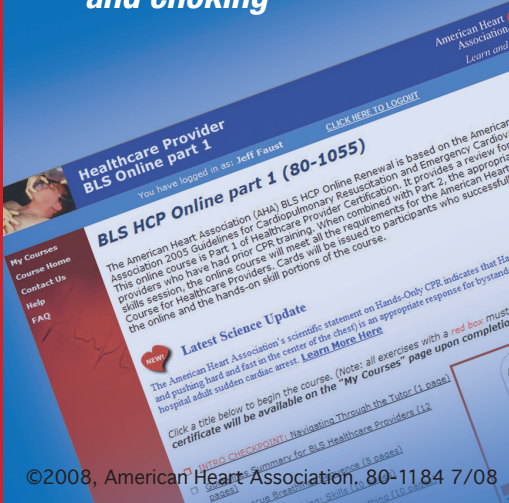
This course is an ideal option for healthcare providers seeking an alternative to traditional classroom training for first-time or renewal certification.
